Spring at Peace

As much as I like a little bit of snow, I like the Springtime better.

A few days ago the kitchen garden committee stood with Burpee seed catalogue in hand, surveying the raised beds which promise fresh food for hungry people visiting our food closet. Potatoes, carrots and peppers will grow where there used to be crab grass. Spring is coming.

I filled out an annual report on a winter's day last week. I was asked "how many people our church touched with ministries of justice, mercy and compassion." Then I thought, "considering the two dozen outreach ministries of our church, from VBS to the food closet, A.A. to A.S.P., I suspect we made a difference in easily over 2,500 persons last year." With a little careful calculation that figure might actually be double that this year. Springtime is coming.

Church membership is like springtime too. We rejoice in new growth, new members, and new responses to God's call. When will the first persons and families come to join and grow here? Maybe it will be someone whom you invited! Plant those invitations! Springtime is coming.

The Lenten Season starts with an evening service at Peace on Ash Wednesday, on February 22nd, and then there will be a rotation of UM Churches of the Spotsylvania Cluster hosting mid-day Wednesday services and lunch throughout Lent. With every gathering with our sister congregations, we declare growing faith in Jesus Christ.

Daffodils are already poking through the cold ground. Look around. Plans are being made for an Easter egg hunt on Palm Sunday, and a dramatic Palm procession on April 1st. No April fool - Springtime is coming.

An Easter Cantata is planned. We could use extra voices NOW in the choir. Springtime is coming.

The warmth of our "Peace in Fredericksburg" concert series started with the Celtic sounds of Castlebay on January 27th, and our Spring concert on Friday, June 1st, will feature the return of "The Taters." Springtime is coming.

This Spring marks the 30th anniversary of the first Peace UMC worship service, the founding of this young church in May 1982. We're starting to plan a 30th year Homecoming Celebration on Sunday September 16th.

And stay tuned for a Spring family camping date. Spring is coming. Rethink Church. This is a place where you can change the world for the better. This is a place where you can grow, and can grow fruitfully, and make a real positive difference in the world.

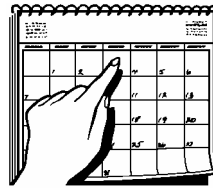

Valentine's Day Dinner Organized by U.M. Men



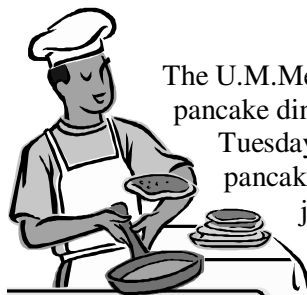

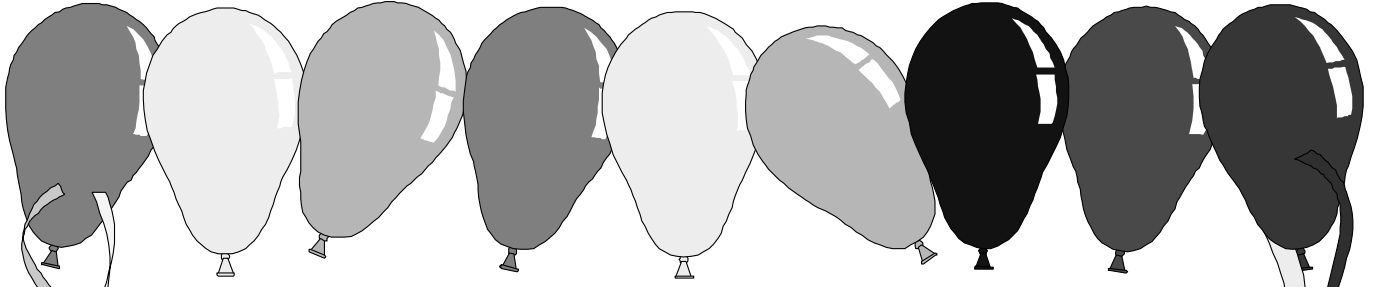


Welcome New Members

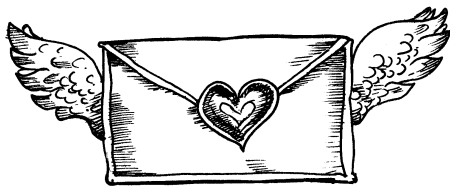
